SPECIES DESCRIPTIONS

Channel Catfish

Excellent for food & sport fishing.

Hybrid Bluegill

The Hybrid Bluegill is a cross between a green sunfish and a regular bluegill. These fish are similar to a regular bluegill, however they grow at a quicker rate and get a larger size. The hybrid bluegill are more aggressive than the regular bluegill because of the green sunfish mix in them. Hybrid bluegill will reproduce, however they are 90 to 95 percent male. A hybrid bluegill can grow up to 4 lbs., however typically they only get 1 1/2 to 2 lbs.

Largemouth Bass

One of the most popular game fish. Works well to control and prevent stunting of bluegill and crappie population.

Redear

Redear Sunfish should be stocked in Bluegill/Bass stocking combinations as a biological control for snails.

Blue gill

Ideal panfish. They reproduce several times throughout the summer and provide a constant food source for bass.

Fathead Minnows

Especially important when stocking new ponds.
Good food source for young bass.

Triploid Grass Carp

An excellent alternative to using chemicals for weed control in ponds & lakes.
Stocking rates depend on the amount of weeds present & the size of the pond/lake.
