

## SPECIES DESCRIPTIONS

### **River Birch.**

Great for Wetland areas. Tolerates wet to dry sites, unique exfoliating bark, spreading limbs, and resistant to bark borer

### **American Beautyberry**

Great for Forrest. A loose branched shrub, with fall fruits on new growth, wildlife food. Best fruit in full sun

### **Native Pecan**

Great with Forrest and Wetland Environments. Largest of the hickory family. Sweet ,and Edible nuts favored by wildlife and people. Excellent Specialty Crop

### **American Filbert**

Great for Forrest. Annual crop of small, sweet nuts for wildlife or humans

### **Persimmon**

Great for Wetlands, Savanna, and Forrest. Slow growing, shrubby tree. Known for sweet, orange fall fruits. Suitable for wildlife.

### **Sycamore**

Great with Wetlands. Matures to massive trunk with distinctive, exfoliating bark and spreading crown. Winter landscape standout.

### **Cherry Bark Oak**

Great with Wetlands, Forrest, and Savanna. Valuable red oak with larger, better form than southern red oak. Excellent for timber. Great acorn production

### **Paw Paw**

Great for Prairies. Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree. Fruiting requires cross pollinations from un related pawpaw. Great Wildlife benefit
